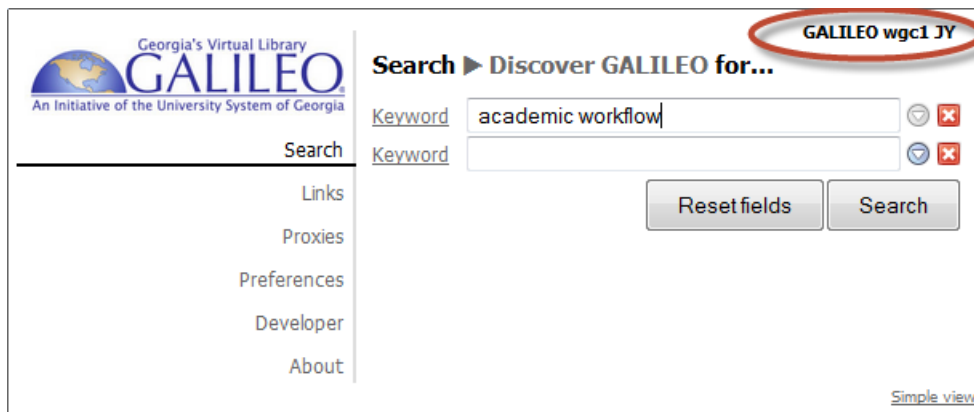
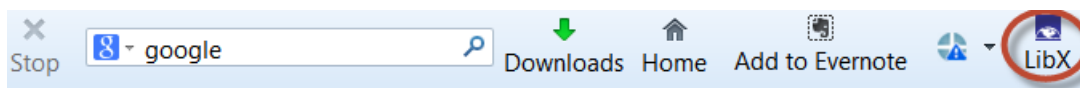


I tried to put myself in your shoes and think about express links to library resources. I persuaded GALILEO Support Services, Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia to allow me to copy their earlier LibX version for UWG. I then customized it to suit Nursing:



You can tell if you have the correct version in two ways. One, the installed plug-in should appear in the top right corner of your Firefox browser:



And two, when you click on the LibX icon, you will see the menu shown above and it will have GALILEO wgc1 JY to identify it.

I have stress tested it and it seems robust, although it would still be considered beta. However, if you wish to use it to replace your old version of LibX, or even to start afresh with LibX, the direct link is <http://libx.org/releases/ff/libx2-latest.xpi?edition=FB3167E5> for Firefox, and <http://libx.org/releases/gc/install.php?edition=FB3167E5> for Google Chrome. It is the fastest, most hassle free way to get to Galileo resources.
