Possible complications

Post anaesthesia related issues e.g. physiological parameters not around normal, aspiration.

In closing the surgical site poor apposition of the muscle layers can result in dead space which can allow for the accumulation of fluid which can promote infection. Seroma.

Peritonitis.

Trauma to the incision site especially when trying to stand when recovering from anaesthesia.

Muscular weakness at the surgical site.

Abdominal fistula.

Incisional hernia.

Adhesions.

Wound dehiscence

Death.
