

Common Pathologies and Complications

- The most lameness occurs on the outside claws of the hindlimbs which have the highest weight bearing pressure.
- Common pathologies and complications include:
 - Injury to hoof / limb due to equipment accidents
 - Exacerbation of lameness due to improper technique
 - Dermatitis
 - solar ulcer
 - Infection of limb
 - Strawberry foot rot / heel
 - Ascending tendonitis
 - Sepsis
 - Development of disease in remaining digit
 - Abscess formation
 - Fracture disease
